### **FREDERICKTOWN CHRISTMAS WALK ORNAMENT SALE**

The 8th Annual Fredericktown Christmas Walk commemorative ornament has been released and is available for purchase. The design this year depicts the old village fire house once located on the Village Square. Previous ornaments have featured the Village gazebo, the feed mill, the Historical Society building, the old school, the Bicentennial emblem, a Christmas scene, and the Ball clock.

These unique solid pewter ornaments are paid for in part by a donation from the Fredericktown Village Council and will be for sale at local Fredericktown businesses throughout the Christmas season for a donation of \$15. These local businesses are, Grubb's Feed Express, Huff's Fine Jewelers, A Taste of Country, the Fredericktown Community Library and a few others to be announced. Ornaments will be for sale during the Christmas Walk on Sunday, December 6th from noon to 5 p.m. in the old store front on the corner of College and Main. In addition to the new ornaments, a limited number of ornaments are still available from previous years. These ornaments will be sold for \$10 on the day of the Christmas Walk and through the local merchants.

The first 25 ornaments have been stamped and numbered and are sold each year for \$25 each. The first three of this set will be auctioned off during the Food For The Hungry Charity Auction on Sunday, December 6th at the Senior Citizen's Building starting at 1 p.m. Families who have obtained particular numbered ornaments from previous years will be given the opportunity to reserve the same ornament number this year. All proceeds from the sale of this ornament will be used to support the efforts of Fredericktown Salvation Army and Interchurch Social Services.
